**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 21 (PART), PARISH OF EATON-  
UNDER-HEYWOOD)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

This Order is made by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Council that in the interests of the landowner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A (2) of the Wildlife Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Shropshire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Whitefields Farm in the Parish of Eaton-under-Heywood and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.

2. Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Order statutory undertakers shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 above, namely, where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same right in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situated at Whitefields Farm in the Parish of Eaton-under-Heywood described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order and thereupon the Shropshire definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.

3A. The Shropshire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this order.

4. The diversion of the footpath shall only have effect on the date on which Shropshire Council certifies that any works required to bring the footpath into a fit condition have been carried out.

5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

## **SCHEDULE**

### **PART 1**

#### **Description of site of existing path or way**

The full width of Eaton-under-Heywood footpath 21 (part) commencing from grid reference SO 50062 90949, Point A on the Order Map, and then running in a general west direction to grid reference SO 4998 9094, continuing in a general west-southwest direction to meet the continuation of footpath 21 at grid reference SO 4981 9087, Point B on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 270 metres.

### **PART 2**

#### **Description of site of new path or way**

A footpath will be created commencing from the County Road at grid reference SO 50057 90944, Point C on the Order Map, and then running in a general west direction on the north side of a field boundary to grid reference SO 4993 9095, continuing in a general south-west direction to where it meets the continuation of footpath 21 at grid reference SO 4981 9087, Point B on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 280 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

### **PART 3**

#### **Limitations and conditions**

Gates are located at grid references: SO 50057 90944 and SO 4981 9087

### **PART 4**

#### **Modification of Definitive Statement**

A footpath will be created commencing from the County Road at grid reference SO 50057 90944, Point C on the Order Map, and then running in a general west direction on the north side of a field boundary to grid reference SO 4993 9095, continuing in a general south-west direction to where it meets the continuation of footpath 21 at grid reference SO 4981 9087, Point B on the Order Map. A total distance of approximately 280 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

There is no Shropshire definitive statement for the remainder of this Right of Way.

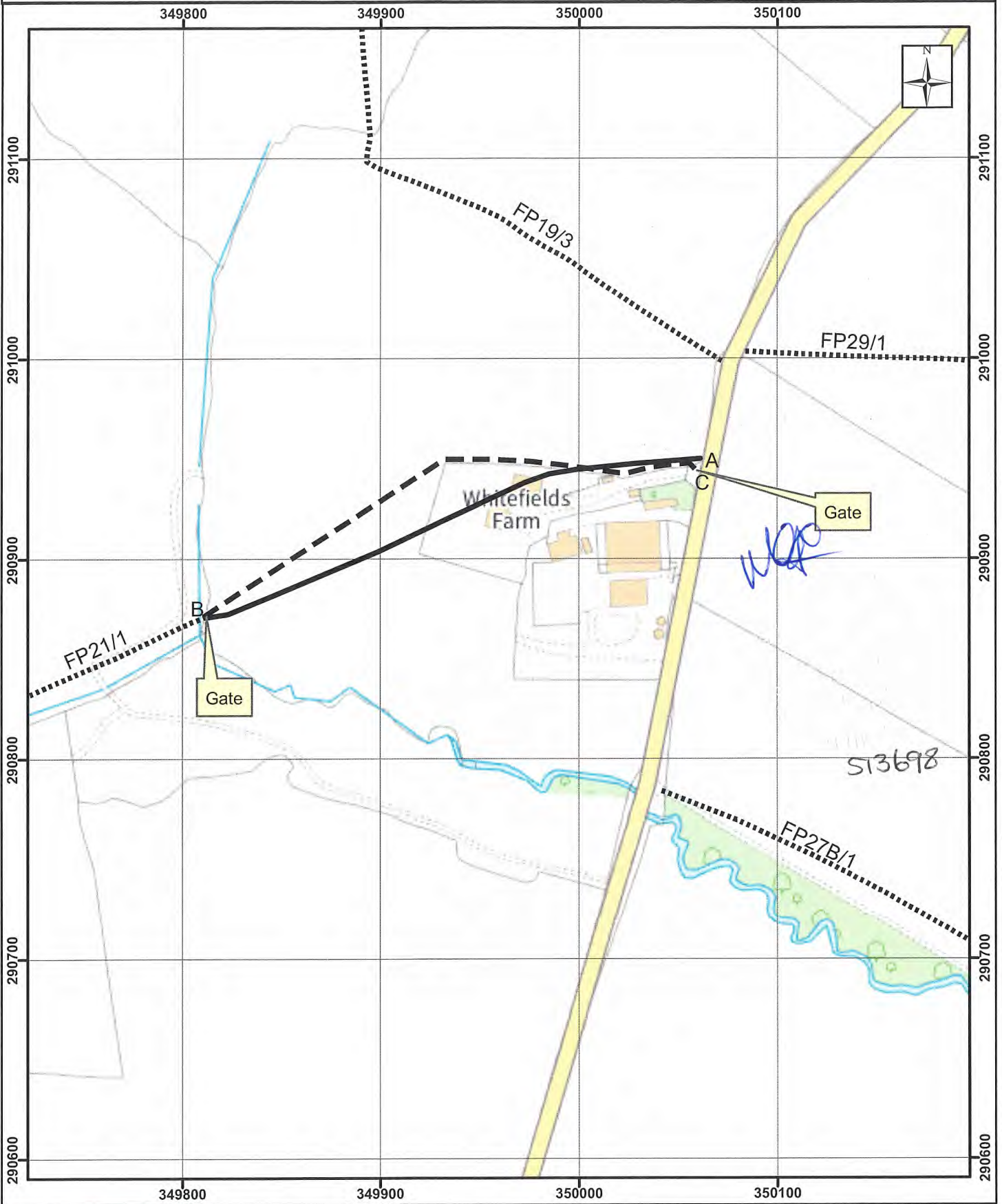
